- Johnston County's non-profit provider for women and children who have been battered and/or sexually assaulted and for women in transition
- A United Way of the Greater Triangle Agency
- Highly credentialed and experienced staff including a certified victim advocate
- Strong base of specially trained, active volunteers
- Volunteer Board of Directors that includes leaders from the legal, medical, educational, and business communities
- Emergency shelter with transitional housing
- Empowerment groups for women and children
- Children's programs including safety planning, school enrollment assistance, summer programs for children while they are out of school, and weekend activities
- Court advocacy assisting with restraining orders, criminal warrants, and presence during all hearings after the initial court process begins
- Hospital companionship for battered and/or sexually assaulted individuals
- Employment services assisting with resume writing, computer lab, budgeting sessions, and job searches
- Transportation services for victims to their job sites and children to their daycares
- Operation of two upscale retail stores; 1 in Smithfield and 1 in Clayton, NC
- Dedicated services 24 hours a day, 365 days a year
